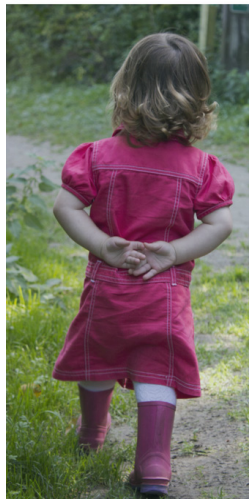


### Coles Sport For Schools
