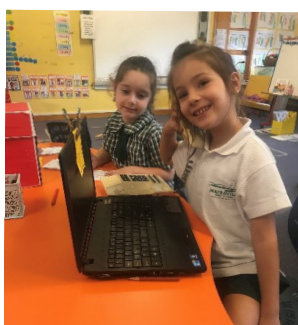

## Enrichment

All of our Kindergarten children actively participate in our Language Enrichment Groups (LEGs) program each Tuesday. This program has been devised to give our children the opportunity to cultivate basic language skills in their

lives. Language and the other skills acquired help children to communicate better with those that are around them. The program comprises of reading stories, singing, drama, activities, writing and much more! Students can also dress up and use props to develop language around a given topic.



### NRMA Incursion

On Wednesday 5 June the students at Matraville Public School will be participating in an NRMA Science and Road Safety Day where they will learn about:

- STOP, LOOK, LISTEN and THINK before crossing the road.
- Holding hands with an adult when near cars and when crossing the road.
- The need for seatbelts to sit across the hip and collarbone for maximum safety.
- The dangers of distracting the driver in the car.
- Using the safety door (the one closest to the footpath) when entering and exiting a car.
- How to fit a bike helmet correctly.
