NRMA Incursion

The NRMA Science and Road Safety Show presented the what, where and how of road safety. Students in K-6 were engaged in learning about a range of road safety

strategies to apply in real life situations. Kate, the presenter, used science demonstrations to ensure students understood how the forces they experience whilst in motion can injure them in a crash, and why safety equipment, including seatbelts and bike helmets, are essential to their safety. After the experiments students were explicitly taught how to correctly fit their bike helmets and why the correct fit is essential for their safety.
